WOLVES GEAR: We will be having Wolves Gear on display to check for sizes. All ordering will be done online through your Rycor account.


#### SCHOOLOGY

### **RYCOR - School Fees DUE NOW**

- 2. Click on the "Quick Links" tab to access PowerSchool.

3. Sign in using your PowerSchool Username and Password. If you have forgotten either/or, click the link "Forgot username password?" and follow the instructions or contact the school office for assistance.

- 4. Click on the link, 'School Fees and Forms', on the left side.
- 5. Please follow the instructions provided on the screen when you are taken to RYCOR.

  - Please log in to your account to update your records. Even if you have NO CHANGES a form must be submitted.
