Highlights

- Learning Engagement: At 88.1%, our school maintains strong learning engagement, exceeding the provincial average of 83.7% and highlighting the ongoing commitment of students and staff to active participation in learning.
- Access to Supports and Services: Despite a slight decrease, our result of 88.3% remains significantly above the provincial average of 79.9%, showcasing the strength of our support systems for students.
- Welcoming, Caring, Safe, and Respectful Learning Environment (WCRSLE): Our score of 85.8% continues to surpass the provincial average of 84.0%, reflecting the dedication of our school community to fostering a positive and inclusive environment.

- We enhance student participation and critical thinking by embedding structured engagement strategies, promoting cognitive discussions, and integrating high-yield practices informed by feedback.
- Despite budget constraints, we strengthen learning supports by scheduling LIFT teachers and EAs, collaborating with community agencies, and expanding capacity in technology and accommodations for equitable student support.
